AGREEMENT OF FELLOWSHIP

- As baptized believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, we join together as the Beenleigh and District Baptist Church, a local expression of the Body of Christ.
- 2. We believe that we have been called by God into the Body of Christ, that we might each serve the Lord Jesus Christ who is our Head; that we might serve one another, walking in brotherly love, seeking to spur one another on to love and good works, building one another up in our most holy faith, always endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace; that we might serve the "lost" by being obedient to the Great Commission of Christ and bring to them the message of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. Accordingly we will meet together on the Lord's Day, and at other times as we have opportunity, and support, by our regular attendance, the meetings of the Church. We will pray for and encourage the officers of the Church in the discharge of their duties, and will esteem and acknowledge our Pastor/s as over us in the Lord.
- 4. We will pray for them, support their ministry, and by all means endeavour to encourage them in their high and holy calling. We will contribute freely for the expenses of the ministries of the Church, and generally observe and do all other duties required of us by the Word of God.
- 5. We will strive together in the cause of the Gospel, seeking to extend the Kingdom of Christ in our own locality and to the uttermost parts of the earth.
